

## Poekie Valentine's No-Sew Outfit

**Materials needed:** Stretchy fabric (preferably fleece) and scissors.

### 1) Top:

Trace and cut the big heart two times, make sure to watch the arrow for the stretchy direction. Snip four teeny teeny holes in each of the hearts, in the places where the pattern is marked with the number 1.

Cut four skinny strips of fabric for the ties. Lay the two hearts on top of each other, right sides out, and tie them together putting the strips in the matching holes, on shoulders and sides. Tie two tight knots each and cut the extra strip off.

### 2) Skirt:

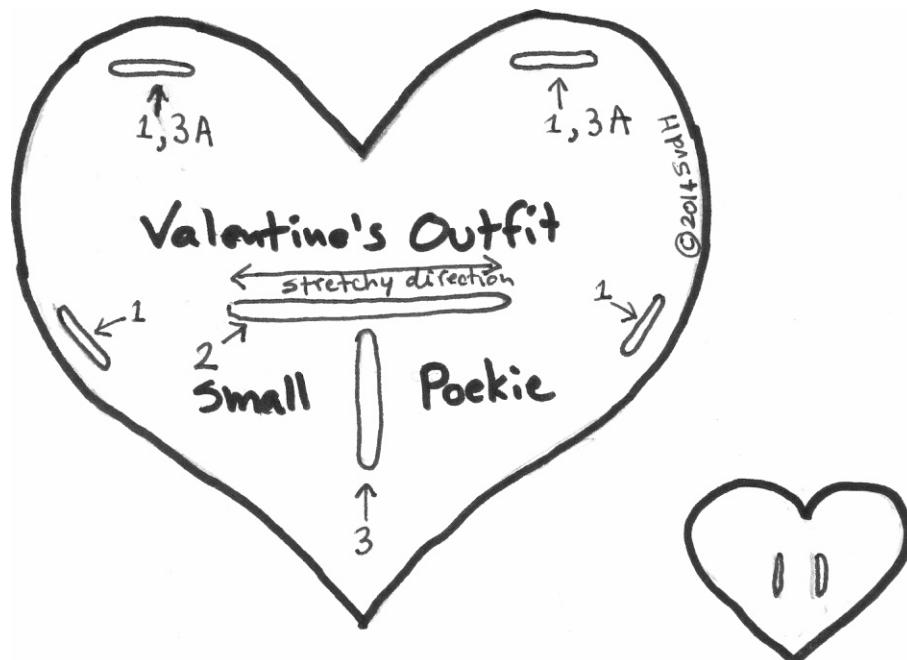
Trace and cut one big heart. Snip a skinny hole in the place where the pattern is marked with the number 2. You may need to enlarge it, but try it on first. The bottom point of the heart goes in the front.

### 3) Hat:

Trace and cut one heart. Snip a skinny hole in the place where the pattern is marked with the number 3, and two teeny teeny holes where the pattern is marked with the number 3A. Put the bigger hole over one of the ears. Cut a skinny strip of fabric, and tie the holes of 3A together below the other ear.

### 4) Headband:

Cut two small hearts. Snip two small holes as marked on the pattern. Cut a skinny strip of fabric and use it to go down and up through both holes of both hearts (like a running stitch). If you can, tie a knot with the strip of fabric so that the hearts crunch up a bit. Tie the headband around your Poekie's head.



\* For children age 8 and up, with parental guidance.

Warning: 1. Pins and needles' mission in life is to poke, and scissors only know how to cut. You must be careful and make sure that they poke and cut only the things that you want them to! 2. None of the materials used belong in a person's mouth, so be careful when you make this while little children are around you.

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
