



Instructions for Poekie Easy Cape (big and small)

(Time to complete: 10 minutes)

Materials needed:

- Paper for your printer
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Fabric
- Marker or pen for tracing
- Pin
- Needle
- String

How to make it:

For an experienced Poekie maker this is easy to make. After printing and cutting the pattern,^{*2} follow these steps:

- Place the cape pattern on an edge on the wrong side of your fabric.^{*3}
- Trace around the pattern.
- Cut ON the lines you traced.
- Thread the needle with the (colorful) string and do a running stitch^{*6} as marked with the striped line on the pattern.
- Tie the cape around your Poekie and find the right place to cut the armholes.
- Cut the armholes and your cape is done!

I can't wait to see what you've made at home and let me know if any part of these instructions is confusing!

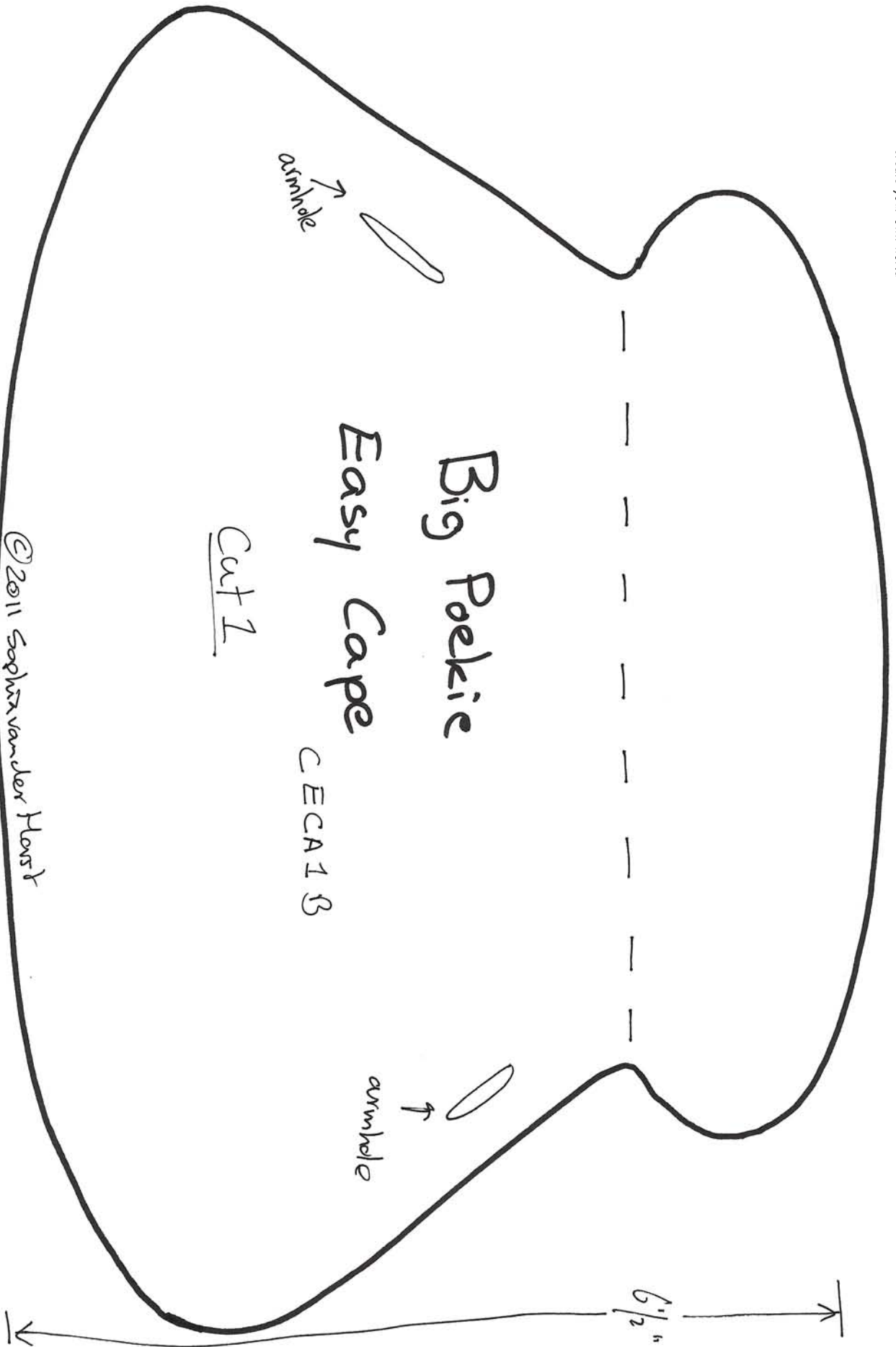
